
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
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
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


















REVIEWER'S COMMENTS

Title of the article reviewed:

Analysis of Performance and Efficiency of Supply Chain of Harum Maluku 52 Oil

Summary

This study aims to analyze the efficiency and performance of the Harum Maluku 52 oil supply chain. The analysis methods used in this study are market margin analysis, farmer share method, profit cost ratio method and SCOR analysis method. The results showed, based on SCOR analysis, the value of supply chain performance value of Harum Maluku 52

Oil is 70.29 which means good. Based on the results of the analysis using margin share, farmer's share, and cost-benefit ratio, both supply chain channels can be said to be efficient. When compared, supply chain channel II is more efficient than supply chain channel I. In addition, there are some shortcomings in this paper that need to be carefully revised by the author.

Major Issues

In the article, the language in the paragraphs lacks logic and the explanation is incomplete. Do not explain half of some things, but explain them clearly. Only in this way can readers better and faster understand this article. Moreover, it can also enrich the content of the article. In addition, the results of this paper lack their own thinking. The result is to introduce the results of this study, rather than citing other people's literature as their own results.

Minor Issues

ABSTRACT:

This part lacks a brief introduction to the research background and innovation points.
 It is suggested that the author should include all the contents of this article in the abstract.

INTRODUCTION:

• This section lacks a brief introduction to the content framework behind the article. The author is suggested to add this part.

RESEARCH METHODS:

- "Farmers' share has a negative relationship with marketing margin" Why is there a negative correlation between farmers' shares and profit rate of sales? It is suggested that the author explain the reason clearly.
- It is recommended that the author center the title of the table.

RESULT AND DISCUSSION:

- This part of the content should write the results of this study, rather than citing more literature as their own results. It is suggested that the author strengthen his thinking and write his own research results.
- "The process of making and distributing products to customers is the most effective and efficient way for companies to remain successful and is at the center of supply chain management (SCM) development [17]." The word meaning here is repeated. It is suggested that the author delete a word.
- What are the results of this study? Why cite others' literature?
- "Without good performance, the company will experience failure and loss both financially and non-financially [22]." What are the financial and non-financial losses?
- "it the importance of having a standard unit for measuring company performance." What is the standard unit for measuring company performance?

- "it turns out to have a bad impact on the company because there is no evaluation material to improve company performance" How can the evaluation materials improve the company's performance?
- "The higher the marketing margin, the more inefficient the marketing system is." What is the basis of this sentence?
